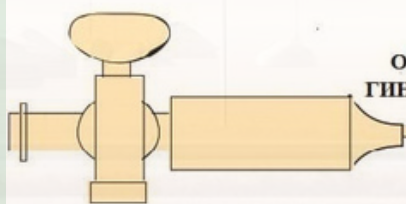

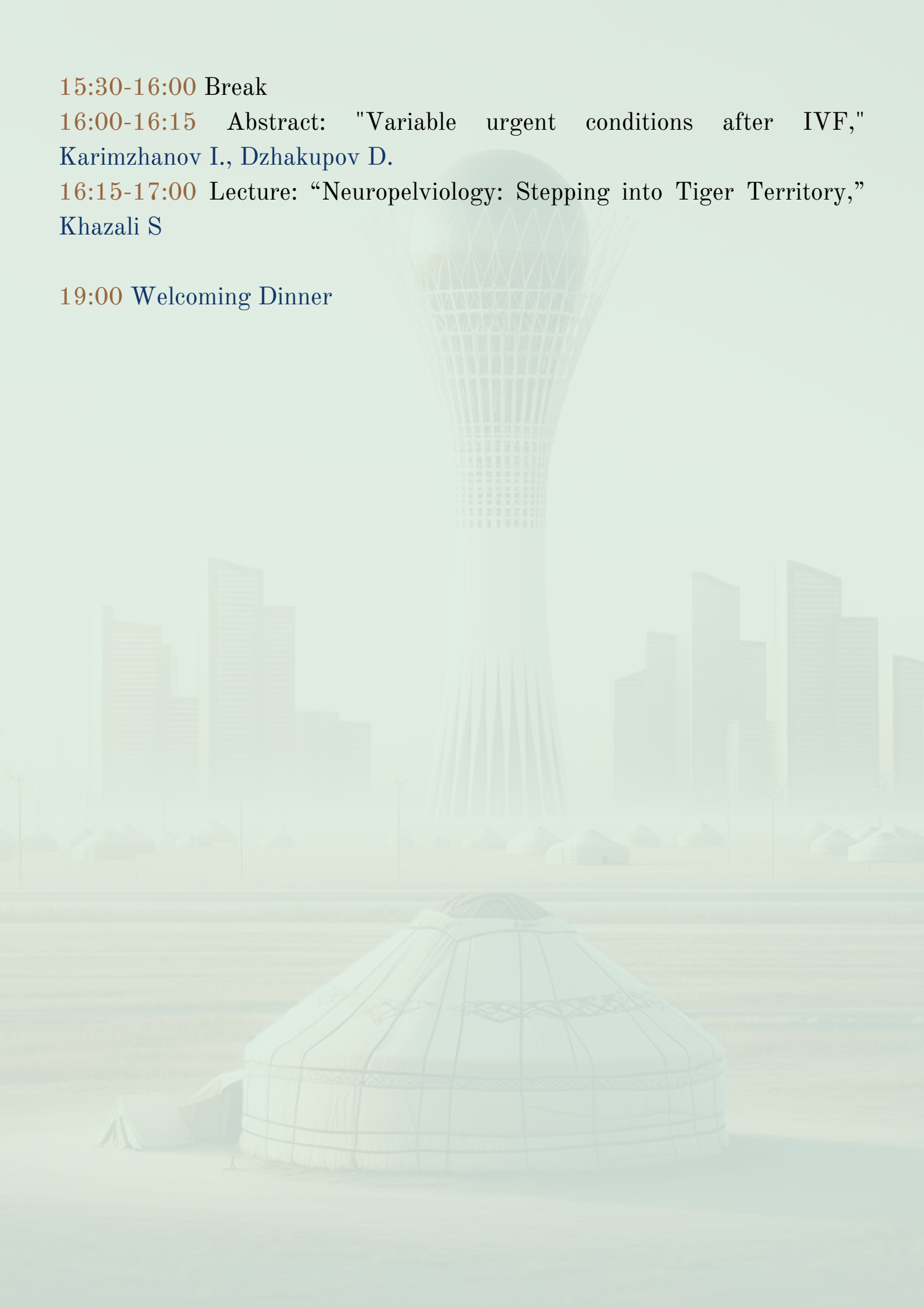

Gauri Bapayeva

MD, PhD, Obstetrician-Gynecologist, Professor, and Director of the Women's Health Department at UMC. Graduated from the Alma-Ata State Medical Institute. A scholarship holder of the Bolashak program, she underwent internships in Germany, Austria, the USA, Italy, the UK, and neighboring countries. The professor leads various scientific projects and thematic cycles. Under her supervision, numerous PhD and MSc theses have been submitted. She is the author of more than 150 publications, including those in international journals indexed in the Web of Sciences database (Hirsch index 11), and is a co-author of international patents.



Jan Baekelandt

Jan Baekelandt trained as gynecologic oncologic surgeon in Belgium, Germany and South-Africa. He currently consults at Imelda Hospital (Bonheiden, Belgium), specializing in gynaecological oncology, and endoscopic and robotic surgery. He is guest professor at the Catholic University of Leuven, department of development and regeneration (in urogenital, abdominal and plastic surgery). He has a research affiliation with the University of Lund, Sweden. Since 2012 his research mainly focusses on vNOTES. He has performed over 2500 vNOTES cases to date.



Alexander Basos

MD, PhD, Obstetrician-Gynecologist. Head of Operative Gynecology at the Clinic of High Medical Technologies of St. Petersburg State University. Under his supervision, more than two thousand high-tech surgical interventions for uterine myoma, endometriosis, ovarian masses, genital prolapse, and other gynecological diseases are performed annually, as well as more than seven hundred hysteroscopic interventions. Alexander Bassos studied and trained in France, Germany, and Italy. For twenty years, he has specialized in minimally invasive operative gynecology, laparoscopic surgery of endometriosis, intrauterine surgery, and has been professionally engaged in urogynecology and oncogynecology. His professional interests include the standardization and optimization of surgical interventions, the reduction of surgical risks, innovations in gynecologic surgery, and surgical training. He is an expert in the application of surgical energies in laparoscopic and intrauterine surgery.

MD, MBA, Tutor of the Department of Postgraduate Education in
Kazakh-Russian Medical University. Almaty, Kazakhstan.



Daniyar Dzhakupov

MD, PhD, Obstetrician-Gynecologist, and Deputy Director of the IRM Clinic Chain. Head of the Course on Endovideosurgery at the IRM, and one of the leaders in endovideosurgery in gynecology in Kazakhstan. He actively conducts traveling master classes for gynecologists and surgeons across the regions of Kazakhstan. Author of more than 30 scientific publications and holder of 4 patents, he was awarded the badge "Densaulyk saqtau isine koskan ulesi ylesi ushin" for his contributions to healthcare. His total work experience spans more than 25 years.



Bolat Ishangali

Obstetrician-gynecologist at Sofiemedgroup Multidisciplinary Clinic, Aktau, Kazakhstan. Author of scientific papers in the field of gynecological minimally invasive surgery.

In his spare time, he is actively engaged in sports.



Shingo Fujii

As the successor to Okabayashi's radical hysterectomy (1921) and Mibayashi's super-radical hysterectomy (1941), established at Kyoto University, Shingo Fujii sought to clarify the precise anatomy necessary for Okabayashi's radical hysterectomy. This endeavor enabled him to preserve nerve function to the urinary bladder, known as Nerve-sparing radical hysterectomy, and led to the publication of a textbook titled "Precise Neurovascular Anatomy for Radical Hysterectomy" with Kentaro Sekiyama, released by Springer in 2020. He has published more than 300 English papers in peer-reviewed journals and served as President of the Japan Society of Obstetrics and Gynecology (JSOG) in 2004, as well as President of the International Gynecologic Cancer Society (IGCS) during 2010-2012.

He is an Honorary Fellow of The American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, The Society of Obstetricians and Gynecologists of Canada, The Japan Society of Obstetrics and Gynecology, The Korean Society of Obstetrics and Gynecology, and the Taiwan Association of Obstetrics and Gynecology.

St. Joseph Hospital. Dortmund, Germany



Murat Kairbayev

MD, PhD, Obstetrician-Gynecologist, Oncologist, and Director of Almaty Sema Hospital. A full member of the International and European Society of Gynecologic Oncologists and a member of the American Association of Gynecological Laparoscopy.

He graduated from the Kazakh National Medical University named after S.D. Asfendiyarov and is a PhD alumnus of the Kazakh Research Institute of Oncology and Radiology. He is one of the founders and the first Head of the multidisciplinary center of oncogynecology at the KazNIIOIR. He is also a graduate of the "Principles and Practice of Clinical Research" program at Harvard Medical School, a fellow of the Leipzig School of Radical Pelvic Surgery, and the International Gynecologic Cancer Society (as a trainee of the Gynecologic Oncogynecology Center at the Main Women's Hospital of Prince Harry's Hospital, Sydney). Additionally, he is a grant holder of the European Society of Gynecologic Oncologists.

Laura Kappusheva

Laura Kappusheva is an Obstetrician-Gynecologist, Doctor of Medical Sciences, Professor, and Honored Physician of the Russian Federation. She serves as the Deputy Chief Physician for Gynecology at the K+31 Clinic. In 2002, she was awarded the Prize of the Government of the Russian Federation for the Development and Introduction of Endoscopic Methods into Gynecological Practice. She is a Professor in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at the Pediatrics Faculty of the Russian Research Medical University and an author of more than 100 scientific publications. She is also a member of the Russian Association of Obstetrician-Gynecologists, the Russian Association of Endometriosis, the European Society of Obstetrician-Gynecologists, and the European Association of Endoscopic Gynecologists.



Islam Karimzhanov

Gynecologist-surgeon at the IRM clinic. Graduated from the Kazakh National Medical University named after S.D. Asfendiyarov.

Participated in several foreign internships in South Korea, Seoul (Catholic University of St. Mary's Hospital), and the "Intuitive" center of robotic surgery in Turkey, Istanbul Medical Park, and Turkey's Ankara Lokman Hospital.



Kamila Kenbayeva

An Obstetrician-Gynecologist at the Corporate Fund "University Medical Center," she is a graduate of the St. Petersburg Medical University named after Academician I.P. Pavlov. She completed her residency at the Corporate Fund "University Medical Center" and has had international internships in France, the USA, the Czech Republic, Italy, Greece, and Russia. In less than five years, she has successfully mastered operative techniques such as laparoscopic sacrocolpopexy, lateral fixation, hybrid pelvic floor reconstruction, sling urethropexy, and laparoscopic metroplasty, among others.



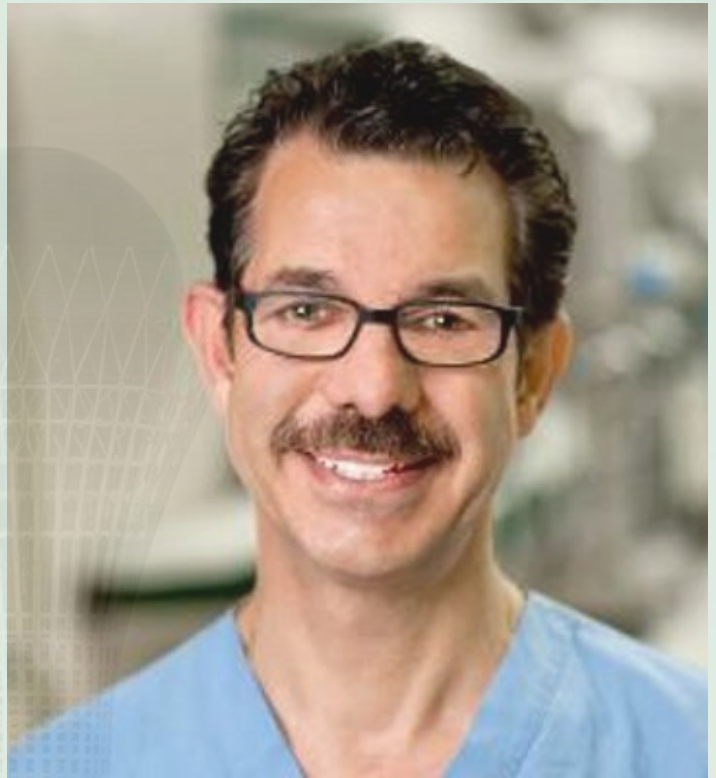
Shaheen Khazali

Mr. Khazali is an internationally renowned expert in advanced robotic and laparoscopic endometriosis surgery, as well as in minimally invasive gynecology. His practice is almost exclusively dedicated to caring for women with the most severe forms of endometriosis, especially when the disease affects other organs such as the bowel, bladder, ureters, and pelvic nerves. He also treats women with other benign gynecological conditions, including heavy menstrual bleeding, ovarian cysts, and menstrual disorders. Almost all of Mr. Khazali's procedures are performed either robotically (da Vinci Xi) or laparoscopically, with robotic surgery offered at the HCA Lister Hospital in Chelsea and laparoscopic surgery available at all locations. Mr. Khazali sees patients at clinics in multiple locations in London (Chelsea) and Surrey (Woking and Chertsey). He is one of the very few surgeons worldwide with formal training in Neuropelveology, enabling him to offer treatments to patients where pelvic nerves are affected, either by endometriosis or other pathologies. Mr. Khazali is passionate about training other gynecologists who wish to become endometriosis surgeons or those seeking to acquire advanced skills in gynecological surgery.



Yelena Luchshayeva

An Obstetrician-Gynecologist at the Corporate Fund "University Medical Center," and Chief Supervisory Pediatric Gynecologist of the Republic of Kazakhstan. She was trained in Germany, France, Italy, and Russia. She is the initiator and author of several national protocols for the treatment of various gynecological diseases. Regularly conducts training courses, seminars, and advanced master classes for doctors.



Ceana Nezhat

Dr. Ceana Nezhat is an internationally renowned Minimally Invasive Surgeon with expertise in the treatment of multi organ endometriosis and fertility enhancing surgery. He has pioneered many procedures for the advancement of surgery with video laparoscopy and robotic techniques. His practice in Atlanta is devoted to women's wellness, and in addition to the highest quality of surgical skill, his primary focus is patient care. Dr. Nezhat has served as the Chair of the Department for OBGYN at Northside Hospital, president of AAGL and Society of Reproductive Surgeons. Dr. Nezhat regularly serves as a medical volunteer in under-developed countries and is widely sought after for teaching and lecturing. He is Adjunct Clinical Professor at Emory University and Fellowship Director at Nezhat Medical Center. Dr. Ceana Nezhat has authored and co-authored extensive bibliographies and award winning publications, and has also received numerous awards commending his surgical skills, pioneering techniques, and teaching.

Almaty, Kazakhstan

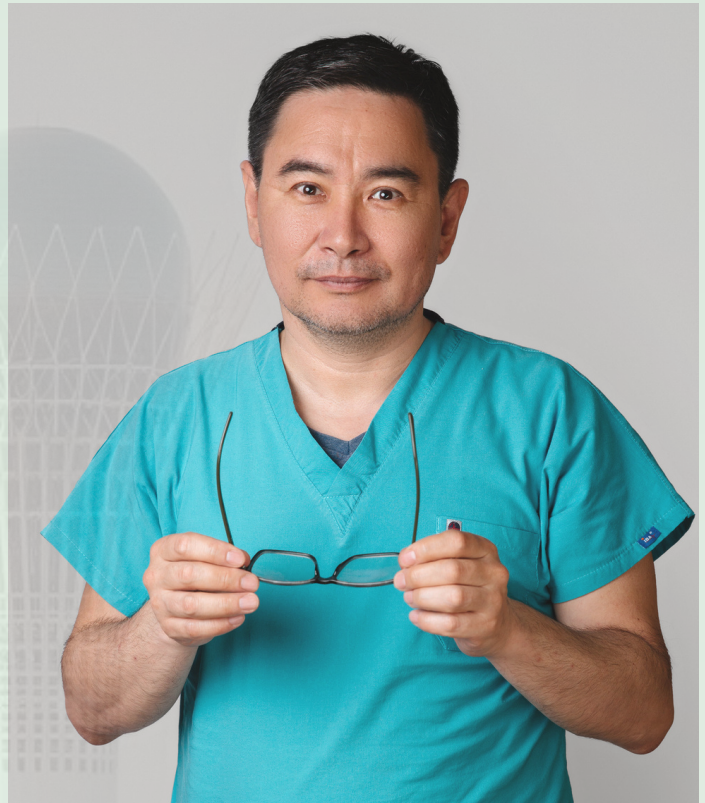


Alexander Popov

Alexander Popov is the Head of the Department of Operative Gynecology with Oncogynecology and One-Day Clinic at the Moscow Regional Research Institute of Obstetrics and Gynecology, named after Academician V.I. Krasnopol'sky. He also serves as the Head of the Moscow Regional Endometriosis Center.

In 1989, he became the first surgeon in Russia to perform a laparoscopic appendectomy. In 2001, Professor Popov was awarded the Russian Government Prize for his role in introducing endoscopic methods for diagnosis and treatment in modern gynecology, marking him as one of the pioneers of robot-assisted surgery in the field within Russia. He annually leads training seminars and certification courses in endoscopic surgery, urogynecology, and reproductive surgery.

Professor Popov is a member of several professional associations, including the Russian Association of Human Reproduction (RAHR), the Russian Association of Gynecologic Endoscopists (RAGE), the Russian Association of Endometriosis (RAE), the American Association of Gynecologic Laparoscopists (AAGL), European Society for Gynaecological Endoscopy (ESGE), the European Endometriosis League (EEL), the World Endometriosis Society (WES), and the Society of European Robotic Gynecological Surgery (SERGS).



Galymzhan Toktarbekov

An Obstetrician-Gynecologist of the Corporate Fund “University Medical Center.”

Dr. Toktarbekov is an honoree of the “Excellent Health Care Worker” award. Scholar of the Bolashak program. He studied in Germany, Austria, France, Italy, Russia, and Spain. Regularly conducts training courses on operative gynecology within the regions of Kazakhstan and beyond.



Talshyn Ukybassova

MD, Phd, Professor, Obstetrician-Gynecologist of the Corporate Fund “University Medical Center”

Talshyn Ukybassova is the first gynecologist to introduce the technique of laparoscopy in Kazakhstan and the first medical professional to perform the first hysterectomy in Kazakhstani medical society. She is the author of 258 scientific articles, 2 textbooks, 14 manuals, and 18 inventions. The professor has mentored 34 masters of science and 2 doctoral candidates.
